



On 14 April 2025, Liaquat College of Medicine & Dentistry's Department of Community Dentistry and Al-Furqan Welfare Organization (AFWO) formalized their partnership with a Memorandum of Understanding. Under this agreement, LCMD will deliver comprehensive oral health assessments and preventive treatments—such as fluoride applications, sealants, and personalized hygiene education—across AFWO's 16+ campuses. Each school visit will also include interactive sessions for teachers and staff, along with the distribution of oral hygiene kits. AFWO will facilitate scheduling, parental consent, and on-site logistics, while LCMD ensures ethical data collection for research and quality improvement.


COMMENCEMENT DAY & WHITE COAT CEREMONY

Crafting Care and Culture: Tayyaba Siddiqui's Blend of Dentistry & Arabic Calligraphy"


Tayyaba Siddiqui Third-year BDS student
