

ORAL HEALTH AWARENESS

- ✓ **Poor Oral Hygiene** Inadequate brushing and flossing lead to plaque buildup.
- ✓ **Smoking** Tobacco weakens the immune system, making it harder to fight infection.
- ✓ **Diabetes** Uncontrolled diabetes increases the risk of infections, including gum disease.
- ✓ **Hormonal Changes** Pregnancy and menopause can make gums more sensitive.
- ✓ **Genetics** Some individuals are more prone to gum issues due to hereditary factors.

Symptoms to Watch For

- ♦ Swollen, red, or bleeding gums
- ♦ Persistent bad breath
- ♠ Receding gums or loose teeth
- ♦ Pain while chewing

Prevention & Treatment

- ☐ **Brush Twice Daily** Use fluoride toothpaste and a softbristled brush.
- ☐ **Floss Regularly** This removes plaque from between
- ☐ **Visit the Dentist** Routine check-ups and professional cleanings are essential.
- ☐ **Quit Smoking** Tobacco increases the severity of gum disease.
- ☐ **Maintain a Healthy Diet** Nutrient-rich foods support gum health.

Gum disease is preventable with proper care and awareness. By prioritizing oral hygiene and seeking early intervention, you can safeguard your smile and overall health.
